

Changes to eNeRGy Kidz Covid 19 Procedures - Effective May 17, 2021

We are excited to let you know about some changes to our COVID 19 procedures after the governor's press conference on Friday, May 14th.

As of Monday the 17th, eNeRGy Kidz will be opening the lobby for parents to be able to come in and watch some of your child's class. We know everyone is excited to come in and see your child in class, please be conscientious of those around you and help us keep the lobbies from being overcrowded. **We are asking that all eNeRGy staff and parents/adults that enter our facility continue to wear a mask while in the building.** If you prefer not to wear a mask, SpotTV will continue to run so that you are able to remotely watch classes from a mobile device or computer. Again, for the safety of the children and the fact that we have no way of knowing who is vaccinated or not, we are requiring that all staff and adults continue to wear a mask anytime that they are in the building.

However, we are NOT requiring children to wear a mask while participating in their class but are asking that all children wear their mask while entering and exiting the building and anytime they are in the lobby. Children are welcome to wear a mask in class if they choose, in order to feel more comfortable. There may be occasions where some of the classes or programs may ask the children to put on their mask due to activities that may require close proximity (ie. cheer or dance). Our staff and other adults in the facility will continue to wear the mask so that we can help keep the children safe!

We are continuing to review our COVID 19 procedures and will update everyone accordingly! Thank you again for your dedication and allowing us to be a part of your child's lives. We look forward to a great couple of weeks and don't forget to register for the 2021-2022 session if you have not done so!
